

Edinburgh Award Global Citizenship (on campus)

What is it and who can participate?

The Edinburgh Award for Global Citizenship (on campus) is designed to recognise students who play an active role in empowering individuals and groups to feel a part of and/or understand their place in a community of global citizens. The Edinburgh Award in Global Citizenship (on campus) helps you to work towards excellence in your role, and it celebrates the fantastic work that you do to make a positive impact at the University. This Award recognises activity on campus, not overseas.

To be eligible, activities classified under the theme '[Global Citizenship](#)' will need to provide the student with the opportunity to:

- a) Demonstrate a high level of cross-cultural competency, and/or
- b) Volunteer for initiatives which support international students, and/or
- c) Facilitate platforms of engagement around global challenges, and/or
- d) Organise activities which bring students together from a range of different cultures.

Recognised activities include, but are not limited to:

- a) Tandem Language Programme: volunteers and committee members,
- b) Buddies Scheme: Edinburgh Buddies and committee members,
- c) Gather Ambassadors,
- d) Globally-focussed society committee members,
- e) International Student Centre committee members and volunteers.

What's involved?

Between September and April you will need to spend at least 50 hours of your own chosen activity and attend Edinburgh Award input sessions throughout the year.

You will also need to submit various input assessments at three stages, in October, November-January, and the last one in March. The types of assessments include references, reflections, and peer assessments.

How do I sign up?
